THE Directorate of Education (DoE) has invited the New Delhi Municipal Council (NDMC) to participate in the online admission process for the academic session 2024-25 in schools where entry level admissions are done through the computerised lottery system.

The director of education has written to the NDMC director seeking his approval for the same.

The DoE is going to start process of admission for candidates under EWS/DG & CWSN category at entry level (nursery/preschool, KG/primary, class I) in private unaided recognised schools of NDMC (except minorities school) for the session 2024-25. Now, Director (Education), NDMC is hereby requested to participate in the computerised draw of lots for admissions for 2024-25 and send

the proposal to include the NDMC schools for the same, if agreed and the proposal for acceptance may be send to the DoE," said the DoE notification.

The director stated, "You are requested to give your consent for participation in the above said process and submit details in the consolidated list of private unaided recognised schools on government and private land separately by November 15 in hard and soft copy. You are requested to nominate a concerned officer for detailed briefing on the matter on November 3."

To maintain the uniformity in EWS/DG/CWSN category admission process at entry level classes, it was decided by the competent authority to conduct the online admission process under RTE Act, 2009 for the academic session 2024-25 also.

In order to ensure a smooth admissions for EWS/DG & CWSN categories, GNCTD has introduced a process where applications are invited online and candidates selected through computerised lottery

THE Delhi government has directed all its departments to geo-tagging the projects and works for which approval is to be sought from the finance department, officials said on Monday. The move aims to check misuse of funds, corruption, quality of work and timely completion of the projects.

Last month, Delhi L-G VK Saxena directed mandatory geo-tagging of all civil work-related projects of the government departments to curb corruption, cost escalation and delay in their execution.

A memo issued by the Finance department to heads of different government departments stated that they would ensure that the projects or works for which concurrence of the department was sought for the release of funds, loans or advances, were geo-tagged and updated real-time.

The order was issued by the Chief Secretary in September who also doubles up as chief vigilance officer of the Delhi government to check misuse of funds and corruption.

WHILE sentencing two people with charges of rioting, causing injury to public servants among others, a Delhi Court observed that lack of education, influence of mob sentiments and young age of both the convicts cannot be overlooked.

Additional Sessions Judge Pulastya Pramachala at Karkardooma court, said, "Sentence have to be decided taking a middle path." The case is related to a mob violence during the Anti-CAA protests in 2020, in which the duo were part of it. As per the police, one of the convicts was carrying a pistol and he fired gunshots at the police team, in which one police person suffered a simple injury on his leg. Among the duo, Imran Malik was sentenced to undergo rigorous imprisonment for seven years while another person Imran Rashid got rigorous imprisonment for five years under Section 307 IPC (attempt to murder).

'Shot at police team'

As per the police, one of the convicts was carrying a pistol and he fired gunshots at the police team, in which one police person suffered a simple injury on his leg

As per the order, both convicts shall pay a fine of ₹25,000 each. In default of payment of fine, each convict shall undergo simple imprisonment for a period of one year six months.

During the hearing, their counsel Adv Vijay Goswami argued that both convicts are young and unmarried persons. They have a duty towards their families. They have not been convicted in any case till date. Therefore, a lenient approach be taken towards them.

On the other hand, Special Public Prosecutor Madhukar Pandey, representing the cops, argued that the convicts were involved in heinous crime. The cops argued that it was a crime, committed without any personal reasons.

The court said the duo damaged the properties of innocent people without any hesitation. The convicts participated in the riots of their own volition and it could not be said that they were under any duress or compulsion.
